

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causing numerous small lacerations to the victim's back and shoulder area. The defendant struck the victim so many times, the rake was broken into numerous small pieces and destroyed. The victim, out of self defense, chased the defendant out of the yard to the driveway. The defendant continued to "Bow up" to the victim. The victim then grabbed a hammer out of self defense and struck the defendant three times. The defendant was later apprehended at 9025 Pontiac Street after being tracked by a K-9 unit. The victim then positively identified the defendant when conducting a show up. The defendant had injuries consistent with where the victim advised he struck him with his hammer and had matching tattoos the victim distinctly described. The defendant invoked his Miranda Warnings, refusing to speak with me. Based on the totality of circumstances, the location of the battery and weapon used, and the positive identification of the defendant, I placed the defendant under arrest for Burglary with an Aggravated Battery. I transported the defendant to the Land O Lakes Jail without incident.
