(specify probable cause for each charge)

Before Me, the undersigned authority personally appeared Sofc. J. Koller #E30 who being duly sworn, alleges, on information and belief, that on the 12 day of July, 2018, in Lake County, Florida, the defendant did:

Commit the act of 1 count retail theft (FSS. 812.014(3)(c) in the city limits of Eustis, FL.

On 07-12-18 at approximately 12:00 P.M. Ofc. S. Stroupe #E51 was at the Dollar General store at 1101 N. Bay St. in reference to a possible drunk person. While there he was contacted by the store manager Iris Martinez who advised him she thought the suspect from a recent burglary (Eustis P.D. case #E18070944) to the store was currently inside the store. Martinez advised she recognized the suspect from the store surveillance footage and that he was wearing the exact same shirt as he was at the time of the incident. The shirt is navy blue and says "This guy needs a beer". Stroupe made contact with the suspect outside the store and also recognized him from the store surveillance footage and placed him into custody. The suspect was searched incident to arrest and a pack of smoked sausages were located under his shirt that he had just stolen as well as a cell phone charger and a cell phone charger adapter. Total value of merchandise stolen was \$17.95. Stroupe identified the suspect as David Jo DeVoss by his Florida identification card and read him his Miranda warnings. DeVoss waived his rights and spoke with officers. He advised that he was currently addicted to crack cocaine and was homeless. He advised on the night of July 10th he came to the Dollar General and used a shopping cart to break through the front window and go inside the business. He advised he stole two 4 packs of Natural Ice can beer and then went to the cigarette case where he attempted to use a broom to break into it but he was unsuccessful. DeVoss also admitted to stealing the three items located on his person today.

A check of his criminal history showed that he has had three previous convictions for petit theft in the past.

Commit the acts of 1 count Burglary to a structure (FSS. 810.02(4), 1 count Petit theft 4th offense (FSS. 812.014(3)(a) and 1 count Criminal mischief (FSS. 806.13(2)(b) in the city limits of Eustis, FL.

On July 10, 2018, at approximately 2312 hours, I responded to the Dollar General at 1101 N. Bay St. in reference to an alarm. The interior front and 360 motion sensors were activated. The alarm was not audible at the time I arrived.

Upon arrival, I parked my patrol vehicle on the east side of the business and walked toward the front door. I observed broken glass from the front left sliding glass door inside the store and notified dispatch of my findings. Responding officers set up a perimeter around the business in an effort to prevent the escape of a suspect that may still be inside. The Lake County Sheriff's Office was requested to assist with a k9 unit and more officers to assist with the perimeter. The LCSO k9 was deployed and made entry into the store. It was determined that there was nobody inside the store at the time.

The store manager, Iris M. Martinez was contacted and responded to the scene. Iris stated that before she left, she walked outside to check if the amount of vehicle in the parking lot matched the number of customers in the store. Iris noticed an unidentified white male sitting on the curb next to the ice cooler that she recognized as a regular customer. Iris advised that the man asked her what time the store closed and she advised 2200. Iris said that she believes the man drives a maroon colored four-door sedan that was parked on the west side of the business. Iris advised that she and another employee locked up the store and left at about 2245 hours.

Iris accessed surveillance system and allowed me to view the footage. I observed, at approximately 2307 hours, an unidentified white male walked up to the door and began kicking the lower glass section of the left sliding glass door at the front of the business. After failed attempts to break the glass, he walks outside of the view of the camera. He then comes back into view pushing a shopping cart and begins ramming the shopping cart into the glass of the door. He is eventually able to break the glass. At approximately 2310 hours, he entered into the business and proceeded to go straight to the freezer section and goes off camera. When the man comes back into a camera shot he is coming around the end of the cash registers carrying what appears to be 2 - four-pack cans of Busch Light. The man then grabs a red trash can with a bag inside of it, and places the beers inside the bag, then removes the bag from the trash can. The man then grabs a mop that was located behind the registers and proceeds to attempt to break into the tobacco case. He broke the mop handle, then threw it down and kicked the tobacco case door. The man was unable to gain access into the tobacco case and proceeded to exit the store.

Upon physical inspection of the scene, I observed the shopping cart located directly in front of the door. The shopping cart was damaged due to the repeated impact of striking the glass door. I observed a large amount of glass on the inside of the business as if it were broken inward from an outside force. I walked behind the cash register and noticed a broken mop handle, along with the mop head that was removed, laying on the ground in front of the tobacco case. I observed the freezer section which showed that the price tags on two separate shelves were knocked off of the display inside the freezer.

I took photographs of the scene and submitted into evidence. The mop handle was recovered and submitted into evidence for further processing. I processed the shopping cart for latent fingerprints but was unable to obtain a fingerprint. Iris was unable to download the video for evidence but advised another manager would be able to do so in the morning. Iris mentioned that the suspect is a customer that frequently shops at that location. I took a photo of the suspect from the video surveillance and sent an email throughout the police department asking for assistance in identifying him.

On July 10, 2018, at approximately 2115 hours I responded to 901 S. Eustis St., to relieve Cpl. B. Jenkins who responded first, in reference to the complainant, Charles R. Flanders, advising that David J Devoss stole his laptop computer.

Upon arrival, I met with Charles who informed me that he rents a room to David. Charles advised that he left his house at approximately 0600 hours to go to work and left his laptop on the dinner table. When he arrived home at approximately 1945 hours, he noticed that his laptop was no longer on the table where he left it. Charles knocked on David's door and David said that he was sleeping. Charles asked David where his laptop was and David answered that he will be right out. Charles then went around the side of the house and seen that the window screen was taken out of David's window. Charles looked inside the room and could see the door to the room was barricaded, but David was gone. Charles provided a written statement.

Charles estimated the value of the laptop to be \$300.00. Charles does not know the make or model and does not have the serial number for the laptop. David was unable to be located. There were no witnesses that saw David take the laptop. I provided Charles with a department-issued business card with the case number to reference if he is able to provide any further information.

On 07-12-18 at approximately 12:00 P.M. Ofc. S. Stroupe #E51 was at the Dollar General store at 1101 N. Bay St. in reference to a possible drunk person. While there he was contacted by the store manager Iris Martinez who advised him she thought the suspect from a recent burglary (Eustis P.D. case #E18070944) to the store was currently inside the store. Martinez advised she recognized the suspect from the store surveillance footage and that he was wearing the exact same shirt as he was at the time of the incident. The shirt is navy blue and says "This guy needs a beer". Stroupe made contact with the suspect outside the store and also recognized him from the store surveillance footage and placed him into custody. The suspect was searched incident to arrest and a pack of smoked sausages were located under his shirt that he had just stolen as well as a cell phone charger and a cell phone charger adapter. Total value of merchandise stolen was \$17.95. Stroupe identified the suspect as David Jo DeVoss by his Florida identification card and read him his Miranda warnings. Devoss waved his rights and spoke with officers. He advised that he was currently addicted to crack cocaine and was homeless. He advised on the night of July 10th he came to the Dollar General and used a shopping cart to break through the front window and go inside the business. He advised he stole two 4 packs of Natural Ice can beer and then went to the cigarette case where he attempted to use a broom to break into it but he was unsuccessful. Devoss also admitted to stealing the three items located on his person today.
