PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT:

(specify probable cause for each charge)

Before Me. the undersigned authority personally appeared OFFICER W. DIAZ 239 who being duly sworn, alleges, on information and belief, that on the 12th day of MARCH, 2020, in LAKE County, Florida, the defendant did:

commit the following offenses,

- Indecent Exposure pursuant Florida State Statute 800.03,
- Battery pursuant Florida State Statute 784.03(1)(A)(1), and
- Resisting Without Violence (x2 Counts) pursuant Florida State Statute 843.02.

On Thursday, March 12, 2020, at approximately 1731 hours, I responded to the Copper Memorial Library located at 2525 Oakley Seaver Drive, Clermont, Florida, in reference to a battery in progress.

Prior to my arrival, responding Officers and myself were advised via Lake County Dispatch that a white male was refusing to leave the library and was actively getting physical with security while security was attempting to remove the male subject from the library. The male subject, later identified as Troy Joseph McCorvey, was described as a white male wearing a purple hoodie and dark jeans. Troy was reported to be allegedly masturbating in the library which is why the library security was attempting to remove Troy from the library. Security then reported that they were chasing Troy in the parking lot, and that Troy had run into the wooded area west of the library.

Upon my arrival, contact was made with Michael Aviles, Security at the library. Michael directed me in the direction in which he had last seen Troy running. Officer B. Reed and myself began to search the wooded area, at which point we spotted Troy, who matched the advised description of the male subject, approximately (50) yards into the wooded area. Officer B. Reed and myself began to make our way into the wooded area towards Troy. We gave Troy multiple loud verbal commands, identifying ourselves to Troy, ordering him to stop and to get on the ground. Troy refused to stop, looking directly at Officer B. Reed and myself, and continued to walk away from us. Upon Officer B. Reed and myself catching up to Troy, we once again gave Troy loud verbal commands, identifying ourselves to Troy, ordering him to stop and to get on the ground. Troy then stopped, sat down on the ground, and Officer B. Reed and myself took hold of Troy's arms, placed them behind his (Troy) back, and placed Troy in double locked handcuffs.

Before Me, the undersigned authority personally appeared _____ who being duly sworn, alleges, on information and belief, that on the 12th day of MARCH, 2020, in LAKE County, Florida, the defendant did:

Upon securing Troy, contact was once again made with Michael Aviles, Security at the library. Michael advised that on March 12, 2020, at approximately 1725 hours, he received a call from the library staff advising him that a white male subject, later identified as Troy Joseph McCorvey, was on one of the library computers watching pornography. Michael advised that, upon making contact with Troy, Michael observed pornographic images on the computer which Troy was utilizing. Michael also observed Troy to have his pants down and removed approximately a quarter of the way down from his waist, exposing his penis and testicles. Michael advised that Troy was actively masturbating. Michael stated that he ordered Troy to get up and leave the library, at which point Troy began to make his way towards the library elevators. Michael stated that he advised Troy that he could not leave through the elevators and that he (Troy) needed to follow him (Michael) down the stairs. Michael stated that Troy ignored his commands and continued into the elevator. Michael advised that he placed his (Michael) arm in-between the elevator doors in order to prevent the doors from closing, at which point Troy grabbed onto Michael's arm and attempted to pull Michael into the elevator. Michael advised that he (Michael) then yanked his (Michael) arm away from Troy and was able to free himself. Troy was able to close the elevator doors even after being ordered by security not to go down the elevator. Michael then once again made contact with Troy by the elevator, on the first floor of the library, and was able to escort Troy out of the library. Upon exiting the library, Troy then began to run towards the wooded area, at which point Law Enforcement arrived on scene.

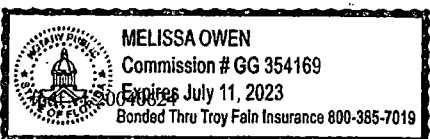

FIRST APPEARANCE FINDINGS & ORDERS

Based upon the foregoing Affidavit and/or Sworn Testimony of the undersigned finds and determines:

- As to charge(s) A B C, that there was at the time of arrest and is probable cause to believe the defendant has committed the offense with which he/she is accused and it is hereby Ordered and Adjudged that defendant is to be detained or post bond as otherwise affixed pending further proceedings.
As to charge(s) that there is a lack of evidence that the defendant committed the offense with which he/she is accused, and it is hereby Ordered and Adjudged that the Sheriff or Chief of Police having custody is directed to forthwith release defendant from custody on defendant's own recognizance, subject to defendant appearing at all subsequent court proceedings upon proper notice.
As to charge(s) that it is hereby Ordered and Adjudged the matter of probable cause is hereby continued until the next First Appearance Hearing after date hereof, at which Hearing the Arresting Agency shall present any further proof of probable cause that it may possess.

RELEASE ORDER

The above named Defendant was brought before the undersigned on this date at 7:30 o'clock, A.M. for a first appearance hearing and the undersigned thereupon informed him/her of the charge against him/her and provided him/her with a copy thereof and also adequately advised him/her that (1) he/she was not required to say anything and that anything he/she did say might be used against him/her, (2) if he/she was financially unable to afford an attorney that the Court would appoint one to represent him/her, and (3) he/she had the right to communicate with his/her attorney, his/her family, or his/her friends and if necessary reasonable means would be provided to enable him/her to do so; and the undersigned having considered all available relevant factors necessary to determine whether bail is necessary to assure Defendant's future appearance, and found that same is necessary, it is upon consideration thereof ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Defendant

- Be released on his/her own recognizance upon the condition that he/she appear as agreed below.
Be admitted to bail in the amount of \$25,000 as to charge A, \$5,000 as to charge B, \$5,000 as to charge C, \$5,000 as to charge D, and \$ as to charge E, upon the condition that he/she appear as agreed below.
